

## FALL LEAF WREATH



This is a wonderful craft project for any age. It's quick to put together and brings some of the outside in.



Fresh Fall leaves in various colors

Paper plate

White school glue

Scissors

Pretty ribbon







## Instructions:

STEP 1 Collect about twenty colorful leaves from outside. Try to get nice fresh ones that have just fallen as they will be easier to

glue on.

**STEPS 2-3** Cut the middle out from a paper plate. Fold the plate in half

to get the cut started in the middle, then cut along the rim to make about a 2 inch paper plate border.

STEP 4 Glue each leaf to the paper plate. Slightly overlap each leaf.

Arrange each leaf to point in the same direction, with the

stems pointing inward.

STEP 5 Clip off the stems from each leaf using scissors.

Tie a pretty Fall ribbon in a bow, then glue the bow on to STEP 6

the wreath.
